**Prior Learning:** family, friends, use of multiple tenses, regions, weather.

Future learning: Jobs, describing towns and cities, holidays and travel (areas of Hispanic interest to visit).

# El alojamiento

What type of holiday do you prefer, what types of trips – hot/cold, in UK/abroad do you prefer, advice for trips and the things that can go wrong on holiday, illnesses (mis vacaciones desastrosas), holiday of my dreams.

**Prior Learning:** ideal types of holiday, discovering new regions, parts of the Hispanic world, different types of accommodation, numbers, introductions.

Future learning:, holidays and travel (areas of Hispanic interest to visit).

## **Influencias**

Roles models, peer relationships, charity work and making the world a better place, what is important in your life, sporting events on larger scales, music and festivals.

**Prior Learning:** relationships, music, sport, passions and hobbies.

**Future learning:** working towards a better world, variety of jobs and apprenticeships.

## Mi futuro

University, future study, the world of work, plans to learn new languages and become more developed linguists, how pupils earn money currently and what is important to them for their futures, work in UK or Spanish speaking countries.

**Prior Learning:** jobs, interests and influences, likes and dislike, regions, travel and tourism.





# Unit 2 Mi tiempo libre

Free time activities that focus on sport and things that you do with your friends and family. What you played yesterday or last week/when you were younger and what you are going to do in the future. What you dislike doing and what you would like to try.

**Prior learning**: family members, friends, free-time activities, opinions.

Future learning: present, past, future and conditional tenses, sport at school and what you would like to try in the future/do if you were rich.

#### Las vacaciones

Transport, travel, time, holiday activities, directions, what you did last year, what you will do next year.

**Prior Learning:** Weather, regions, family, friends, freetime activities, if clauses, multiple tenses.

**Future learning:** ideal types of holiday, discovering new regions, parts of the Hispanic world, different types of accommodation.

## El instituto

Descriptions of school subjects, school uniform – advantages and disadvantages, facilities and how students would change their school, opinions regarding what they enjoy and how to give full descriptions about their school day.

**Prior Learning:** Time, school subjects, opinions on teachers and facilities available, local areas and cardinal points.

**Future learning:** activities in school, the school day, facilities.

#### Las regiones

Weather forecasts and climates in different countries compared to UK, what there is to do in your region, the advantages and disadvantages with comparisons for change, shopping, jobs in the tourism industry, souvenirs, directions.

**Prior Learning:** weather, activities that you can and can't do in your local area, jobs.

Future learning: differences between regions and customs, work and jobs.

## El medio ambiente

Environment: problems around the globe, in Spanish speaking countries and in the UK, solutions at home and in everyday life, planning for the future and how we can all be more environmentally friendly, features of climate.

**Prior Learning:** weather, regions, family, school, friends, travel, transport, holidays.

**Future learning:** global and social issues, problems facing the world, what needs to be done to make a better world.
