

## Big Ideas

Big Ideas are the building blocks of subjects. They are: -

- Concepts and ideas that help us make sense of lots of otherwise isolated or disconnected facts.
- Principles, theories, or processes that serve as a focal point of a subject.
- Something that changes the way we think about information or schema.

The big ideas in this subject are: -

Big Idea	Description
<b>BELIEF</b>	All humans operate a belief system. How is this formed? How does this impact individuals, communities and the wider world?
<b>SOURCES OF AUTHORITY/WISDOM</b>	All beliefs originate from a source of authority/wisdom. These enable humans to make decisions and make sense of the decisions of others.
<b>PRACTICE/TRADITIONS</b>	The impact and application of beliefs on the way people live their life.
<b>IMPACT OF BELIEF ON SOCIETY</b>	The morals, ethics and values of individual communities and societies. The impact of belief on humanity.
<b>NARRATIVE AND MYTHIC</b>	Religious stories (often revealed) that work on several levels. The collection of myths, images and stories through which the invisible world is symbolised.
