Big Ideas are the building blocks of subjects. They are: -

- Concepts and ideas that help us make sense of lots of otherwise isolated or disconnected facts.
- Principles, theories, or processes that serve as a focal point of a subject.
- Something that changes the way we think about information or schema.

The big ideas in this subject are: -

Big Idea	Description
Creative thinking	Understanding the dramatic potential of an initial starting point and the ability to bring those creative ideas into being.
Working together	The ability to work collaboratively with others, contributing ideas to discussion and also listening and developing the ideas of others.
Developing performance skills	Developing a range of performance skills and applying them to create effective performances.
Analyse and Evaluate	Reflecting on your own work, as well as the work of others, allowing the work and your skills to continue to develop.
Theatre in context	An awareness of the social, historical and cultural importance of theatre and the roles and responsibilities of performers, directors and designers.
