Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to share with you your child's Assessment and Celebration timetable which starts from Monday 29th November 2021.

The first assessment cycle of this academic year is fast approaching and as such your child will sit a series of assessments allowing them to demonstrate their learning over this unit. These assessments will take place in their usual lessons between the 29th November and 10th December 2021.

Celebration

Furthermore, this year we now have celebrations and House competitions taking place in the Assessment and Celebration fortnight. More information on which can be found below and in the timetable at the bottom of the letter. Please find answers to some potential questions below. We are extremely excited to welcome as many parents as possible in to see what your children have been learning in enrichment.

What will they need to learn for the assessments? Exam Style Assessments

These assessments will be in the style of real GCSE exams. These assessments will give a good indication of gaps our students have in their knowledge and set off a series of interventions that will ensure every success in the actual exams.

KIP Assessments

The assessments link directly to the work completed for homework and in class. Your child will be given a list of definitions and they will be asked to write next to each definition the keyword that it is describing. These are all the words from the Knowledge Organisers that students have been memorising for homeworks and using in lessons. Since we are in the first part of the assessment cycle, students will be assessed as follows:

- Subjects with 10 weeks of information in the Knowledge Organisers will have 50 definitions in their assessment
- All other subjects will have 20 definitions in their assessment

Students will be tested over the fortnight on each subject according to the timetable written below.

How can I help my child? Exam Style Assessments

Students have been given exam manifests which indicate the subjects that are covered in the exam that they are about to sit, and shows students how to revise for those subjects. Furthermore, ensure your child is doing their structured revision to a high standard each week.

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KIP Assessments

You can help prepare your child for these assessments by quizzing them. Simply find the subject they would like to revise in the knowledge organiser, then read the definition to your child and ask them to say what the key word is. For example, you would say to your child:

'This is a device for measuring the atmospheric pressure of a place'

Hopefully your child will remember the keyword is 'Barometer' and you could tick it in their Knowledge Organiser, it is as simple as that. If they cannot remember, simply tell them the correct answer, then quiz them on it again later.

Please remember there is a video in the "Students" section of the school website demonstrating how students should be memorising this information when they do their homework. It would be worth rewatching this to aid revision.

How will you know how well they do in each assessment?

You will receive a report at the end of the exam period which shows your child's scores/grades in both types of assessments.

What homework do students do in weeks 11,12 & 13?

During these weeks your child's Homework practice book will be used to practice any definitions from their Knowledge Organiser that they do not know.

Celebration and House competitions

During this celebration and assessment fortnight you are able to attend Gloucester Academy and watch your child compete in their house competitions such as Netball and Football, you can watch your child perform in their drama production, attend the Art exhibition and many many more. This is a fantastic opportunity to immerse yourself in the hard work and achievements of your child, to celebrate with them their commitment to their enrichment activity, sport and academic subjects. You can attend all events in purple on the timetable, you will be required to sign in at reception on arrival and will need to be here 10 minutes before the start of the event. As social distancing restrictions ease, we couldn't be more excited to have more parents on site, celebrating the fantastic achievements of their children.
